






























A/C Evaporator Cleaner



Application device for surface disinfection cleaning with spray hose

Observe the handling instructions for the cleaning liquid.

Initial use

- 1 Pour the cleaning liquid into the spray container.
- 2 Close the spray container.
- **3** Connect the sprayer to the compressed air supply.

Preparation

4 Dry the evaporator for ten minutes under the following conditions:

Air-condition	Off	
Air outlet	Down	
Air inlet	Interior	
Ventilator	Max.	
Temperature	Warm	

5 Place the collection container under the evaporator's (A) condensation water outlet and the protection mat into the footwell (B), in order to catch any discharged cleaning agent.



Open all windows!

6 Remove suction filters (C) (pollen filters) (if available).

Handling the evaporator

7 Set the aircon as follows:

Air-condition	Off
Air outlet	Centre
Air inlet	Exterior
Ventilator	Max.
Temperature	Max: Warm

- 8 Insert the spray nozzle into the opening of the filter inlet (D) (or other ideal access to the evaporator). Spray the container contents into the evaporator and guide the spray nozzle across the entire evaporator surface.
- **9** Switch off the ventilator once spraying is completed.
- 10 Reassemble filters and other temporarily removed
- **11** To dry the treated evaporator:

Air-condition	Off
Air outlet	Down
Air inlet	Interior
Ventilator	Max.
Temperature	Warm



Attention

If the smell of alcohol persists, air well with open windows!
